

CDLIS commercial driver consent

Instrument of written consent required before a commercial driver's CDLIS master pointer record data may be requested — DPPA and FCRA compliant.

Commercial Driver License Information System (CDLIS) — Instrument of Written Consent. Required before {Employer Name} may request or access CDLIS data on a commercial driver through SafestHires, Inc., in accordance with the Driver Privacy Protection Act (DPPA), the Fair Credit Reporting Act, and applicable state law. Consents must be retained by the employer for at least three years.

Instrument of written consent for CDLIS inquiry

I, the undersigned commercial driver, hereby authorize {Employer Name} ("Requesting Party") — and SafestHires, Inc. acting as the Requesting Party's consumer reporting agency — to request or access data pertaining to me within the Commercial Driver License Information System ("CDLIS"), to obtain all CDLIS master pointer record data relating to me ("CDLIS Data"), and to request and obtain my driver record from the jurisdiction identified in the CDLIS Data in accordance with applicable state law, the DPPA, and the FCRA. I further authorize the disclosure of my CDLIS Data and driver record to {Employer Name} and to SafestHires.
